Founded in 1965, **Seminole State College of Florida** is a public college located in Sanford, Florida. It is part of the Florida College System and offers associate and bachelor's degrees, along with various certificate programs. Online and on-campus options are available to suit varying student preferences and schedules.

Seminole State's Associate in Science degree in Information Systems Technology provides students with skills and knowledge in desktop and server maintenance and support, virtualization, cloud computing, and cybersecurity. The program features four specializations: Cloud Computing, Cybersecurity, Microsoft Server Administration, and AS to BS (IST). Additionally, the program offers seven technical certificates in Computer Repair and Installation, IT Client Specialist, Network Infrastructure, Network Server Administration,

Network Support Technician, Virtualization and Cloud Computing, and Cybersecurity. Courses are designed to prepare students for leading cybersecurity industry certifications, including Certified Ethical Hacker (C|EH), CompTIA Cloud+, and CompTIA Security+. Guided by experienced faculty, students gain the skills and knowledge necessary to meet the evolving demands of both industry and government sectors.

The program actively partners with Seminole County Public Schools to provide dual enrollment courses, allowing students to earn college credit while completing their high school education. Additionally, it offers summer camps and educational workshops designed to engage high school students in hands-on learning experiences and to foster early interest in academic and career pathways.

In 2020, Seminole State College's Information Systems Technology, Associate in Science Program was one of eight colleges named winner of the inaugural Excellence and Equity in Community College STEM Award by the Aspen Institute College Excellence Program and the Siemens Foundation, recognized for providing outstanding preparation for high-demand jobs in Information Technology.

Furthermore, in 2025, Seminole State College's Information Systems Technology, Associate in Science Program was officially designated as a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense (CAE-CD).
